Moss Park Junior School Uniform list 2021

- ✓ Red Moss Park Junior V neck sweatshirt/cardigan (available from John McHugh now MONKHOUSE in Stretford Mall) or
- ✓ Plain red v neck jumper or cardigan
- ✓ White school shirt (long or short sleeved)
- ✓ **School tie** (John McHugh/Monkhouse) traditional or clip/elastic
- ✓ Black or grey trousers, skirt, pinafore or culottes (not leggings or jogging bottoms)
- ✓ Black school shoes (no heels, sports trainers* or knee boots)
- ✓ Plain grey, white, black or red socks/tights
- ✓ Long hair should be tied back off the face using small hair accessories in black, brown, metallic silver/gold, grey, white or red (no 'cat ears' or large headbands/bows etc.)
- ✓ Suitable coat for school

*Many shoe shops stock black school shoe/trainer crossovers for boys. That is fine. If a black trainer has a white or coloured sole going round it and/or decoration on it is a **sports trainer** and is not acceptable as school uniform.

We have an optional <u>summer uniform (this may then</u> be worn from after Easter holidays until October half term to get the most out of it)

- ✓ Moss Park Junior red polo shirt with logo (John McHugh/Monkhouse) or
- ✓ Plain red polo shirt
- ✓ Red and white striped or checked summer dress (leggings or tights may be worn under these for religious or cultural reasons)
- ✓ Black or grey tailored shorts, skirt, trousers or culottes
- ✓ Plain grey, white, red or black socks
- ✓ White or black sandals (with straps and buckles no slides, thong toe or flip flops)

PE Kit (worn on PE Days with school cardigan/jumper over the top to look smart)

- ✓ Plain Black shorts no sports team logos
- ✓ Plain black leggings
- ✓ Moss Park Junior white PE t shirt with logo (John McHugh/Monkhouse) or
- ✓ Plain white round neck t shirt
- ✓ A pair of plain, basic trainers for outdoor PE
- ✓ A plain black, grey or navy blue sweatshirt or tracksuit/jogging bottoms for outdoor PE in the colder months

Jewellery

One small pair of stud earrings & a watch (not a smart watch) are allowed in school but must be removed for PE. If your child cannot remove their earrings, please teach them to do this or provide your own *micropore* tape to cover ears. We cannot use first aid stock for this purpose. No other jewellery in school.

Clothing and items of religious significance

- ✓ Head coverings worn for religious or cultural purposes should be in plain red, black, grey or white and must not use pins as fixings
- ✓ Any jewellery worn for specifically religious reasons, such as a *kara*, should be limited to one item, and should be removed for PE for health and safety reasons or covered with a sweatband.

Equipment

- ✓ One bag only for all items including reading books, homework etc.
- ✓ Packed lunch box/bag
- ✓ Water bottle essential this year as fountains not being used for drinking directly from (in covid risk assessment)
